Spelling

Children will be given a spelling list of 10 words each week on Friday, which they will be required to practise at home in preparation for a spelling test on the following Friday before receiving their new list. A paper copy of the spelling list will be sent home every Friday. We will also post the list on Class Dojo. We no longer complete the termly badge tests, these words are tested throughout the year in our weekly spellings. Please note, we no longer use Spelling Shed.

Reading

Accelerated Reader (AR) is a computer program that helps teachers to manage and monitor children's independent reading practice. It has been a very successful programme that we have been using at St Stephen's for a while now. It encourages a love of reading, allows children to access a variety of texts and ensures the children understand what they are reading with a small follow up quiz. In Year 3, the children are required to read for at least 10 minutes each day. Your child will be allocated an appropriate reading book, which they will bring home each day. Remember, you can now quiz from home! Please ask your class teacher for the username and password if you would like to quiz at home.

Times Tables

We have now learnt our 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables! Please continue to consolidate these time tables at home. If your child is confident with their times tables, we recommend using TTRS to increase the pace and speed at which they answer times tables questions.

Each term, we complete a times tables check that tests all tables up to 12. If you would like to know the results of the times tables check in more detail, please ask your class teacher. Please continue to practise and learn times tables using whichever method suits you most.
