



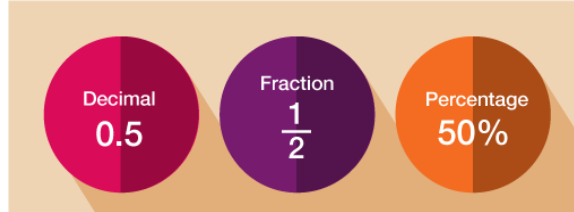
PSHE

This term we think about “**Healthy Me.**” We will be thinking about diet and what we consume, and body image. This will help us to learn about healthy eating, and feeling confident.



Maths

This term, we will build on our learning about fractions by looking at decimals and percentages. We will then look at perimeter and area. Finally, we will finish the term with lessons about statistics!



Science

This term we will be learning all about Animals including humans. We will discuss life cycles, and how animals grow into adulthood.



Computing

We will be starting an exciting new Computing topic this term. We will be looking at digital music creation. We will also carry on the important lessons we started on Safer Internet Day. Staying safe online is a big priority.



English

Our reading lessons will continue to be based around the book *The House with Chicken Legs* by Sophie Anderson. Through our reading lessons, we will develop the **VIPER** skills: widening our **v**ocabulary, making **i**nferences, making **p**redictions, **e**xplaining author intentions, **r**etrieving information and **s**ummarising. Our writing focus will be narrative based on gorillas, and writing balanced arguments about screen use.



RE

Our learning about **Christianity** this term will focus on Easter and the big concepts of incarnation, forgiveness and sacrifice.



Art

Our work this term will be linked to our topic of the ancient Maya. We will look at artwork from that period, and create our own pieces in that style.



Music

Music will link closely to computing this term as we look at producing music on the iPads. The children will be learning about rhythm and composition.

PE

This term we will be playing invasion games – football. We will develop our use of tactics and teamwork.



Spanish

This term we will be learning about families. We will make a presentation about our own/a fictitious family in both spoken and written Spanish.



History

We are learning about **The Maya**. We will discover what life is like in that ancient civilization, and think about how reliable different sources are.
