



Welcome to Year 6 !

We are happy to welcome the children back to a new academic year. We will spend the beginning of term settling everyone in with their new class teachers and into Year 6 life. In addition, we will begin introducing our new topics which we are sure the children will enjoy. Year 6 is an exciting year with plenty of interesting challenges.

Reading

As a school, we endeavour to develop a culture of reading for pleasure. Children should read every day and, if possible, be read to. Early into the term, the children's reading ages will be assessed using Star Reader. From this, your child will bring home a suitable reading book. Once they have completed their book, this should be recorded in their Reading Log and they should complete a quiz on Accelerated Reader which assesses their comprehension.

Spelling

Each week the children will be tested on a spelling list of 10 words. The words will be taught each Monday and tested the following Monday. This will begin in Week 2. A copy of this word list will be sent home and posted on Class Dojo to help children prepare for their test. In addition, throughout the week, the children will complete tasks linked to these spellings.

Homework

Reading: Children should read daily.

Spelling: Children should learn the 10 words sent home ready for the test on Monday.

GPS: Home learning Grammar, Spelling and Punctuation tasks will be sent home for children to complete. More information on this to follow.

Times Tables: At the end of Year 4 children are assessed on their times tables up to 12x. Every Friday children will be tested on their times tables up to and including 12x. Please continue to practise and learn times tables using whichever method suits you most. We encourage children to use Times Tables Rockstars.
