We are pleased to inform you that between September and March each child in Year 6 will take part in swimming lessons. Swimming is a compulsory element of the National Curriculum and all pupils are expected to attend each of their sessions. The aim is to ensure that all children have the opportunity to learn swimming skills.

The children will be taught by a professional swimming teacher who is supported by school staff.

To help prepare for the transition to secondary school, we will be travelling via a **public bus** to the swimming pool in Whitstable. Becoming familiar with reading bus timetables, purchasing tickets and travelling safely are all incredibly useful skills for our children to learn and develop.

For **LEMUR CLASS**, the first session will commence on **Tuesday 9**th **January**. Please note, due to the occasional inconsistencies of public transport, this may impact the end of the day. If there are any changes (including a delayed return), the school will notify you via Parentmail.

- Towel
- Hairbrush

You may also wish to supply your child with a swimming cap, swimming goggles and spare underwear. All items must be clearly labelled with your child's name.

We do recommend your child practising putting on and taking off their swimming costume independently.
