We hope that you have had a lovely week, and are looking forward to the term ahead. Please spend some time reading our Curriculum Overview which outlines the main focus this term in each subject. We have some exciting activities in store, linked to our curriculum, including a **Viking Day on the 2nd April**, where your child may choose to come to school **dressed as a Viking**.

Reading

Quality reading time is built into each school day, but we do also encourage all children to read each day at home, sharing this reading with an adult.

We have timetabled library slots so that children can change reading books regularly, and we ask that the children complete an AR quiz after each book where possible. Your child has their own username and password which they should already be using regularly, but please request on dojo if you need it again.

Spelling

Children will continue to be given a spelling list of 10 words each week on a Thursday, which they should practise in preparation for a spelling test the following week. Before we set these, we will have taught the words and practised them together in class. It is important that the children also practise these spellings at home throughout the week, checking their understanding of the meaning of the words.

Times Tables

As you know, in year 4, the children are expected to work towards a recall of all times tables facts up to 12x12. We teach times tables regularly, within maths lessons and as a separate activity. The children will use Times Tables Rockstars in school to support their learning, but please do encourage them to use this site to continue their practise at home.

Equipment
