Year 6 Curriculum Overview Term 4

Maths

The children will all be rotating maths teacher this term which they are excited for. Each group will be learning about decimals including adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing them. We will then link our decimals understanding to our previous learning on fractions with our Fractions, Decimals and Percentages unit. Then, just before Easter break, we will look at our Area, Perimeter and Volume unit.

English

This term we will explore a range of genres. There is an advertisement for a 'luxury' resort holiday where the children will use persuasive language to convince people to stay at their hotel. They will then be writing a review on this 'luxury' resort and finally create a response to a complaint from the point of view of the manager. We will continue with our class text is 'Darwin's Dragons' by Lindsay Galvin. We will continue to explore a wide range of reading extracts to improve our reading skills.

Science

Our topics this term come under the umbrella of Animals including Humans. We will start by exploring the circulatory system and move into what our bodies need to remain healthy. There will be some links to this term's PSHE. We will also be observing a heart dissection (more information to follow).



PE

This term we will be playing cricket on our Monday PE lessons. On our Tuesday lessons, class teachers will be teaching dance.

History

We will soon be beginning our new History Topic: Ancient Greece. The big question is What were the beliefs, ethos and attitudes of early civilisations? We will look at the role of women during this time period and learn about the Olympic games.
