Thank you to all parents who have already created an account on Arbor or downloaded the App. Over 79% of parents have now downloaded the App and are using it for reporting children's absence, checking on payments, replying to messages giving permission and choosing clubs for children. Please note that you can also pay for both school dinners and uniform using the app.
