Year 3 Curriculum Term 4

Maths

Firstly, we will be learning about length and perimeter. We will be measuring in m, cm and mm as well as learning about equivalent lengths and comparing lengths. After, we will be moving on to fractions and focusing on using and understanding mathematical vocabulary such as numerator, denominator, unit fraction and whole.



Science

In Science, we will be learning about light, we will be learning what a light source is and learning about transparent, translucent and opaque objects.



Computing

Our focus this term will be on digital art. We will be editing and creating art work using different software on the laptops.



RE

In RE, We are learning to recall key events in the Easter story and understand why Jesus’ crucifixion symbolises hope for Christians.

Forest School

We will be going back to Forest School this term! We will recap our key skills such as knots and building shelters.

Spanish

In Spanish, we are learning to say ‘I know how to’ followed by high frequency verbs.

Art

In Art, we are learning about architecture. We are learning about key architects and making transcriptions of their work. We will finish our unit by creating a final piece inspired by Emmie van Biervliet



English

Our reading lessons will be based around the books “Sam Wu is not Afraid of the Dark” Through these texts, we will develop the **VIPER** skills: widening our **v**ocabulary, making **i**nferences, making **p**redictions, explaining author intentions, **r**etrieving information and **s**ummarising. Our writing focus will be an explanation text and a Roman diary entry.

History

In History, we will be learning about the Romans. We will explore what Britain was like before the Romans arrived, the Roman invasion and the rebellion of Boudicca. We will also be going on a trip to the Roman museum!
