PSHE

Our PSHE unit this term is "Relationships" We will be thinking about the roles and responsibilities of our family members, the skills involved in friendship and we will be talking about being safe online.



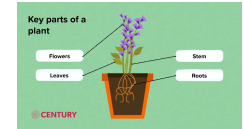
Maths

We will be learning about pounds and pence, converting between pounds and pence, adding and subtracting money and giving change. We will also be learning to tell the time. In Year 3, children should be able to tell time to the minute. It would be great if you could do some time work at home too!



Science

In Science, we will be finishing our unit on light. We will be carrying out our own shadow experiment. After, we will be learning about plants. We will be exploring the parts of a plant and their functions.



Computing

Our focus this term will be on music creation. Our Key question is What is the advantage of creating music on the computer? We will also be discussing if there are any disadvantages.

RE

In RE, we are learning about Sikhism. Our key question is 'Do Sikhs think it is important to share?'

PE

In PE we are doing orienteering! We are going to be working as a team and using maps in our orienteering lessons.
