Science

This term we will be exploring living things, and how they can be grouped and classified. We will use classification keys to sort plants and animals.



Computing

Our **writing** units will include a report about our class animals, and a narrative based on the delightful picture book "Float." Additional practice of handwriting and spellings will also be provided.



RE

Our learning about **Judaism** this term will focus on the question, "How special is the relationship Jews have with God?"



Art

Our learning this term is all about portraiture. We will be exploring how portraits from different art movements differ, and applying the basic rules of portraiture to create and evaluate our own piece.

PE

This term we will be developing basic skills in Football, and using team work to play games. We will also be developing Fitness through a variety of activities.
