



Year 4 Curriculum Term 6

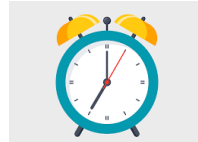
PSHE

This term we think about "Changing me" We will talk about changes in life, such as transitions into new classes. There will also be some RSE content about the physical changes involved at puberty.



Maths

This term we will cover a series of short units about time, money, shape, statistics and position and direction. We will also be revising calculation strategies and mental arithmetic, as well as practising and applying times tables knowledge in readiness for year 5.



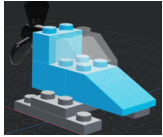
Science

There will be a continued focus on team work this term, whilst we also develop individual athletic skills and practise Sports day events.



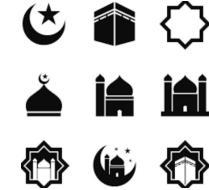
Spanish

This term we will have opportunities to listen to music of different styles, as we consolidate skills such as appraising, performing and improvising.

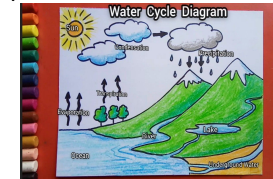
English

We will use a wide variety of other reading extracts throughout the term, which will continue to develop our VIPERS skills. Our writing will be a narrative unit based on the picture book "Flood"



Geography

This term we will be exploring Rivers. We will be recognising the features and courses of rivers, as well as how they are used. We will also be learning about the water cycle, and developing our map work skills. There will be an opportunity for some practical fieldwork in this unit.



DT

Our unit of work on structures will involve researching, designing and building small buildings out of framework materials such as lolly sticks. We look at how we can make these strong and stable.
