

We Model What We Value





PSHE

This term we think about "Being Me in the World." This links strongly to our school value of Belonging. We will be thinking about why rights and responsibilities are important, and how to make our community a fairer place.



Maths

We will start the year by learning the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We will then move on to place value. This topic is crucial as the knowledge forms a basis for all of your child's learning for the rest of the year.



Science

This term we will be learning all about Forces like friction, air resistance and more. This incredibly practical topic promises to be exciting!



Computing

Our focus this term will be on the **e-Safety.** It is important to know how to stay safe online, and what to do if we see or hear something online that upsets us. We will also look at computer networks.



English

Our reading lessons will be based around the book *Street Child* by Berlie Doherty. as well as continuing to read extracts from a range of fiction and nonfiction texts. Through our reading lessons, we will develop the **VIPER** skills: widening our **v**ocabulary, making **i**nferences, making **p**redictions, **e**xplaining author intentions, **r**etrieving information and **s**ummarising.

Our writing focus will be on non-chronological reports about our class animals.



Our learning about **Hinduism** this term will focus on concepts like an omnipotent, omnipresent deity. The children will use their enquiry skills to consider and explore this idea.

<u>Art</u>

We will be looking at landscapes. We will focus on the differences between Impressionist and Romantic styles.



PE

This term we will learning Football in our coached PE sessions, and fitness in our teacher-led sessions. This will develop our teamwork skills whilst also improving overall fitness!

Spanish

This term we will be learning about Spanish phonics and how to correctly pronounce Spanish sounds.



History

We are learning about **The Industrial Revolution** this term. We will discover what life was like in Britain at the time, and making comparisons to modern-day Britain throughout.





We will be looking at cultural music for celebrating harvest around the world. This will include learning about form and pitch in performance.
