



Year 6 Curriculum Term 1



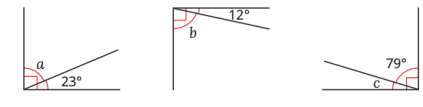
PSHE

This term we think about **"Being me in my World."** We will think about our year ahead whilst considering how to make our school community a better place.



Maths

Year 6 will look at Number and Place Value. During these lessons we will be developing our confidence to compare and order numbers up to 10,000,000. We will then solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, deciding which operations and methods to use and why. Children will be moved into different groups for maths lessons to practise for secondary school.



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Science

Pupils will learn about **Living things and their habitats**. They will describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. They will give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

Computing

This term we will look at E-Safety and complete a unit called **Data Detectives**. We will use spreadsheet tools (filters and conditional formatting) to find the specific data to match the clues.



PE

During PE lessons on Mondays, Miss Wilson will be working on football with the children. With the class teacher, the focus sport will be Basketball.

Spanish

In Spanish, we are going to begin by looking at on our phonetical knowledge. This will see us working on our pronunciation when speaking in Spanish.

RE

The religion Year 6 will focus on this term is **Judaism**. Each topic will focus on exploring a question. Our first will be: **What is the best way for a Jew to show commitment to God?**

English

We will be completing a range of writing pieces inspired by our history topic. These will include narratives and letters.

Our whole class reading lessons will also be based around the book "Our Castle by the Sea". In addition, we will explore extracts across a range of genres, including plays and poetry. Through these texts, we will develop the **VIPER** skills: widening our vocabulary, making inferences and predictions, explaining author intentions, retrieving information and summarising.



Art

We will look to different Art movements for inspiration, comparing and contrasting their features. We will use everything we have explored to create our own self-portraits.



History

We will be learning about **World War 2** in History this term! We will be exploring what life was like on the home front. We will also have a local study where we will be learning about Operation Dynamo, which took place in Dover Castle.
