



## Year 6 Curriculum Term 1



### PSHE

This term we think about **"Being me in my World."** We will think about our year ahead whilst considering how to make our school community a better place.



### Maths

We will begin the year by looking at number and place value; developing confidence to compare and order numbers up to 10,000,000. We will then solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, deciding which operations and methods to use and why. We will use estimation to check answers to calculations and determine, in the context of a problem, an appropriate degree of accuracy. Each Friday, we will have an additional lesson focused on arithmetic and times tables.

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### Science

Pupils will learn about **Living things and their habitats**. They will describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. They will give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

### Computing

Our focus this term will be on the **safe use of digital technology**. We will learn how to create safe and secure passwords as well as the appropriate way of behaving online.



### PE

Netball and Football will be our focuses in term 1.

### Spanish

In Spanish, we are going to begin by looking at our phonetical knowledge. This will see us working on our pronunciation when speaking in Spanish. We will then move onto the unit 'At School' where we will name objects and lessons.

### RE

The religion Year 6 will focus on this term is Islam. The lessons will centre around answering the question: **What is the best way for a Muslim to show commitment to**



God?

### English

In our first week back we will be writing non-chronological reports about our class animals. This term our writing will be linked to our history topic: World War 2. Our whole class reading lessons will also be based around the book "Our Castle by the Sea".

In addition, we will explore extracts across a range of genres, including plays and poetry. Through these texts, we will develop the **VIPER** skills: widening our vocabulary, making inferences and predictions, explaining author intentions, retrieving information and summarising.



### Art

We will look to different Art movements for inspiration, comparing and contrasting their features. We will use everything we have explored to create our own self-portraits.



### History

We will be learning about **World War 2** in History this term! We will be exploring what life was like on the home front. There will be a World War 2 day during term 1. Please stay tuned for further information!
