Art

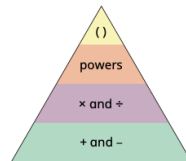
This term we are combining all of our artistic knowledge to create and complete our own self-portraits.

Maths

We will continue with our 'Division' focus after half term. The children will be introduced to long division and learn how to use this efficiently, even with remainders. The children will learn about the order of operations and understand the importance of completing calculations in the correct order. Our next unit will be fractions.

English

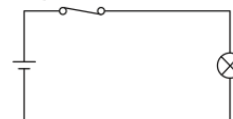
We will explore a few different genres of writing this term. We will be a formal, persuasive letter that will require the children to consider their audience carefully. We will end the term with a narrative that focuses on dialogue.

We will continue with our Class Text of 'Our Castle by the Sea'. The children are excited to find out what happens next!

We will use our Extract Reading lessons to continue exploring a range of texts, including song lyrics, novels and adverts. Each week will have a different theme such as celebrating Black History Month, celebrating songs and celebrating inspirational women.

Science

This term's topic is electricity. The children will build upon their prior learning of circuits to draw and make their own. The children will use their knowledge to predict if a circuit will work and explain the reasoning. We will also have a lesson on renewable energy.



Computing

There will be an cyber-bullying week where we will consider how e-safety is of paramount importance.

In addition, we will look at Binary Code and Python.

History
