Term 4**

**Spanish**

The focus is 'World War 2'. We will be able to combine our History learning with our Spanish vocabulary to read and translate texts.

**PSHE**

In PSHE we are looking at drugs such as caffeine, painkillers and tobacco.



**Maths**

We will continue to build upon our fractions learning from term 2 during our fractions, decimals and percentages topic. This term we will also look at area & perimeter, statistics and shape! The children will be practising their arithmetic multiple times a week too.

**English**

We are continuing our class text of Darwin's Dragons. The children made excellent predictions last term so we will see if any of them were correct!

In writing, we are going to explore lots of different genres. We will be writing narratives and creating our own holiday brochures. We will also write formal and informal letters.

There are so many opportunities for the children's creativity to shine through.

**Science**

This term's topic is the Circulatory System. We will learn about the heart and blood. This unit also involves a heart dissection and Q&A session with a practising doctor later in the term. If you feel uncomfortable watching this, please let your class teacher know so we can plan around this.

**D & T**

This term we will complete our electricity games unit. This is sure to be a challenging topic where the children can combine their science learning from term 1!

**Art**

Our new topic is telling a story through art. This will link to our history topic and we will even have an art day. Keep your eyes peeled for updates.

**History**

This new topic is Ancient Greece. During this unit we learn about how the location impacted the people's way of life. We will compare and contrast two civilisation. The children will learn about the role of women. We will also look at the legacy of the Ancient Greeks.
