Term 5**

**Spanish**

We will be continuing our learning from last term.

**Geography**

We are looking at trade and energy. This topic looks at renewable and non-renewable energy. The case study involved considering how to use renewable energy more effectively in our local area.

**Science**

This term's topic is all about inheritance and adaptation.

**Production**

This term we will begin auditions for our Year 6 production.

**Maths**

We will focus on revising the Key Stage 2 curriculum ahead of the SATs. We will revise arithmetic daily and learn assessment techniques. We will recap learning from Year 3 all the way up to Year 6.

We will refer back to our Canterbury Cathedral trip and begin working on our Year 6 mural. The children are telling the story of the city they live in!

**History**
