Maths

We will now move onto learning about Ratio. We will also be covering Algebra. The children have briefly explored these topics during our preteach sessions and we are excited to consolidate this learning. Our other topics are statistics and measurement.

English

This term we will explore a range of genres. Our final genre will be a narrative inspired by the book 'A Monster Calls' by Patrick Ness. We will continue with our class text is 'Darwin's Dragons' by Lindsay Galvin. We will continue to explore a wide range of reading extracts to improve our reading skills.



Science

Our topics this term come under the umbrella of Animals including Humans. We will start by exploring the circulatory system and move into what our bodies need to remain healthy. There will be some links to this term's PSHE.



PE

It is now the children of Dolphin who will be going swimming! The rest of the year group will be learning to dance with the class teacher.

Computing

We are introducing our new computing scheme this term. The children will be looking at Image Editing.

Geography

We will be completing our field work case study from last term's Geography unit on population.

History

We will soon be beginning our new History Topic: Ancient Greece. We will look at the role of women during this time period and learn about the Olympic games. We will learn about the Gods and Goddesses worshipped and discuss the legacy of Ancient Greece and the people that lived there. There will also be an experience day led by Portals to the Past.
